It is with great pleasure that I present my first annual report as President of Table Tennis Australia. I was greatly honored to be elected to this position in 2004 and I thank the States and Territories for their continued support.

In each Olympic year there is a heightened interest in sport and anecdotal evidence suggests an increase in activity and community awareness. No doubt the amount of media attention leading up to and during the Olympics highlighted the potential our sport has to attract a wide audience in the community.

The opportunity to showcase our sport comes with the Commonwealth Games in Melbourne in 2006. The preparation is well underway and we hope to work towards a successful result on home soil.

This year the board in conjunction with the Australian Sports Commission has reviewed the strategic plan and the operational plan. After consulting with the States and Territories at meetings in Brisbane and Sydney a plan was developed to take us through to 2007.

The last twelve months has been a learning experience and with continued consultation and cooperation with the States and Territories as well as the sub committees of TTA, a brighter future is assured.

I attended both the National Senior and Junior championships and was impressed by how well both were conducted and the high standard from the players and officials. The Board is currently developing pathways to improve the standard of our players, coaches and officials. I believe that working together we can develop high quality programs which will benefit all our members and grow our sport at the National level.

Special thanks to the key personnel in our organization from the members of the board of TTA to the members of our various sub committees who work tirelessly to provide quality service to our membership. Thanks also to Martin Shaw our CEO who has provided support and advice throughout the year to the board and myself.

On a personal note I thank everyone for their support and confidence during the past year.

2004 has been another busy year for Table Tennis Australia, with a high level of activity on many fronts.

A significant amount of the Board's time was taken up with the requirement to have in place a Strategic Plan to meet the Australian Sports Commission's funding requirements. The process, which was run with the assistance of our ASC Consultant, Paul Grogan, was quite exhaustive, involving a series of meetings with Board members and the sport's stakeholders. After a draft plan was compiled a further meeting with representatives from the State and Territory Associations was convened to provide further input into the document and arrive at a strategic direction that had the support of the Voting Members.

The document, which is available on the TTA website, now provides the Board with the basis to manage the future direction of the sport. It will also be used by the ASC in their funding review, which happens on a four yearly cycle. The outcome of the review has an important bearing on the ability of TTA to fund programs at an elite and development level, so the input of the many people who contributed to the Plan is greatly appreciated.

The outcomes from the Strategic Plan will have an effect on the way the sport is managed in Australia. The implementation is planned to coincide with the new Board being elected at this AGM. With a sport such as table tennis, that has little capacity to afford full time staff, it is reliant on volunteers to take on responsibility. As we look to expand the areas of influence of TTA, and look to provide value for our members, we will be aiming to establish dynamic committees that have responsibility, within a defined framework, for driving their area of the sport.

We already have a number of committees that have made a valuable contribution to table tennis this year. The Coaching, Officiating, High Performance, and Athletes With Disabilities Committees have worked diligently to develop their respective areas of the sport. Their achievements for the year are detailed in other areas of this report, so there is no need for me to list them here, but I would like to thank all committee members for their time and input into the sport. We will now be looking to add vibrant committees in other areas identified during the planning process to take table tennis forward.

This year's national championships were again successfully run by a number of states. Congratulations are extended to the tournament organisers – Table Tennis Victoria (Youth Championships), Brisbane Table Tennis Association (Australian Championships), Western Australian Table Tennis Association (Junior Championships) and the Table Tennis ACT (Veterans Championships). These tournaments take a great deal of time and effort from volunteer organisers to get up and running, and the success of the 2004 tournaments is a testament to the abilities of the organisers.

On the international scene, 2004 was an extremely busy year. It started with the World Teams Championships in Qatar, where our women finished 22nd and our men came 37th.

This was followed by the Oceania Championships in Whangarei, New Zealand, where the Australian teams performed extremely well. The Women's team won their event, while the Men lost a closely fought encounter with New Zealand to end up a sliver medallists. The Under 18 Boys and Girls teams both won their events to qualify for the 2004 World

Junior Championships. The Australian team took home a swag of medals in the individual events, but special mention should be made of William Henzell and Miao Miao, who won the Men's and Women's Singles respectively to become the Oceania Champions.

The Commonwealth Championships, in Kuala Lumpur, were an important part of our team's preparation for both the 2004 Olympic Games and the 2006 Commonwealth Games. The results were encouraging, winning bronze medals in both team events, and most members claiming a medal in the individual events.

By far, the highlight of the year was the 2004 Athens Olympic Games. The sport was given great coverage by SBS TV, and those who were lucky enough to see the gold medal matches were treated to some fine table tennis. Australia claimed all four places reserved for Oceania in the men,s events, and two of the four places for women. William Henzell, Trevor Brown and David Zalcberg all made their Olympic debuts, Miao Miao and Jian Fang Lay competing at their second Games, while Russell Lavale earned selection in his third Games team.

A significant addition to the array of TTA programs has come this year with the acceptance of table tennis into Project CONNECT. This is a wonderful opportunity for TTA to work together with the states and territories to develop disability sport. The process of acceptance into CONNECT was long, and would not have been possible without the continued efforts of Arthur Wilks, who has been tireless in supporting the AWD program.

I will record my thanks to the Board members for their continued work in 2004. It is in many ways a thankless task to take on the responsibility for providing the direction for a national sporting organisation, while balancing the many competing issues. Their commitment is greatly appreciated.

Fran Keyhoe (Vic) who has been a member/secretary for many years resigned during the year due to health issues. I would like to give special thanks to Fran for all her work on the Committee for at least 10 years. Her enthusiasm and experience will be sadly missed, and we sincerely trust she will continue to be able to contribute to the recruitment and training of umpires in the future. It is due in no small measure to her efforts in the past that Australia has such good officials, the quality of whom are recognised worldwide.

The TTAOC meeting this year took place on $4^{th} - 5^{th}$ April at Kilsyth, during the rest day at the Australian Olympic Qualifying Tournament. At this meeting, along with a number of other items, we discussed the Level 3 (National Referee) course, which will be the final course to be covered under ASC/NOAS

Five Level 2 courses were given during the year, plus two Level 3 courses. From these courses we now have 3 new National Umpires, a number of new State umpires, and several more are on their way to becoming qualified, having passed the written exam. In addition training was conducted for 6 National Umpires in Victoria who wanted to progress to International Umpire. I am pleased to report that all 7 umpires who sat for the International Umpire exam passed. This is an excellent result for Australia, as the overall pass ratio for the exam was less than 50%.

Due to a variety of circumstances the committee was not as active in the latter part of the year, although we have still done umpire selections for a number of events. Australian officials at major events during the year included Mick McShane (Qld), Maurie Poole (NSW) and Nimo Ramchand (Vic) at the World Championships, Dave Delpratt (Qld), Neil Montfort (Vic) and Steven Lee (NSW) (deputy referee) at the Olympic Games, Maureen Sherman (Tas) at the Commonwealth Championships, and Maurie Poole at the Paralympic Games. The committee has also been responsible for the selection of the Official of the Year Award, which for 2004 went to Mick McShane (Qld).

Australia has 3 approved ITTF Advanced Umpire trainers - Lindsay Drummond (Vic), Phil Males (NSW) and Graeme Ireland (Vic) who were active during 2004 assisting with courses in Korea, Singapore, Malaysia and Qatar. Officials active within the ITTF include Phil Males on the Rules Committee, Ron Keyhoe on the Equipment Committee, and Graeme Ireland on the Technical Committee and special advisor to the Umpires and Referees Committee.

Following completion of the course material, budget permitting, it is intended to hold a 2-day training seminar, during a weekend, in Melbourne and/or Brisbane. National and International Umpires who are interested in becoming National Referees will be invited to attend. This should occur before 30th June.

The other major training exercise to be undertaken this year will be towards the Commonwealth Games in Melbourne in March 2006. We will have 28 umpires (International and National) at the Games, and as far as possible all should receive some refresher training this year, with the emphasis being put on National events.

2004 was a successful year in developing coaching in Australian Table Tennis with the highlight being the Olympic Solidarity Course in August.

Level One coaches are the foundation of a coaching program, and there is always a need for active, qualified coaches. During 2004, the opportunity was given to Members for a subsidy to run a Level One Coaching Course. For the 2003-2004 financial year, the subsidy was \$500 and was taken up by many Members. For 2004-2005, an offer of \$300 is available for Members.

For those wishing to take the next step, the Olympic Solidarity Course held in Melbourne in August was an opportunity for Level One coaches to move to Level Two. Attended by nearly thirty coaches from all around Australia and including two from Guam, the event was a great success. All participants, including those not taking the course as part of their Level Two training, gained much from the experience and knowledge of expert table tennis coach Hubert Hustache of France. Hubert has worked as a coach all over the world, and has extensive experience in running Olympic Solidarity courses for ITTF. As well as the table tennis expert, experts in sports psychology, sports nutrition, strength and conditioning, and athletes with disabilities spoke to coaches. All in all, it was an enjoyable week for all involved, a chance to meet other coaches from around the country as well as learn from experts in our field.

Another important change in coaching this year has been the introduction of a separate panel of selectors for national coaches. The panel, currently comprising Mary Le Gassick as High Performance Director, Bob Tuckett as an independent selector and myself as Coaching Director, was formed late in 2004 and will select coaches for 2005 competitions. In order to open up the selection process, expressions of interest have been called for from the coaching community for the 2005 coaching positions currently anticipated.

On the administrative side, the Level One course was reviewed, with the Committee deciding to tailor the new ITTF Level One Course to suit Australian table tennis requirements. Further information will be available to Members once this course has been formally approved by the ASC.

In 2005, further coaching activities are being planned, including a national training camp, which unfortunately did not happen as originally planned in January. If this goes ahead, there will be opportunities for developing coaches to learn from one of Australia's best coaches.

Another issue that is currently being looked into is member protection, which has a particular significance to those working with juniors.

I would like to take this opportunity to thank the members of the Coaching Committee: Sue Stevenson, Alois Rosario and Mark Smythe for their hard work over the past 18 months.

2004 was a busy year in High Performance in both the competition and planning aspects.

A High Performance forum was held in Melbourne where four members of our current National team attended, along with Glen Tepper representing Oceania, 2 Coaches, several Board members and representatives of the Australian Sports Commission. This proved very fruitful as it provided round table conversation between the Board and our elite athletes on key issues. Two other HP meetings were held again with ASC representation to further develop a High Performance Plan. A lot of work has been completed but much more still has to be done to finally achieve a clear, concise plan & pathway for athletes. We are currently working towards re-establishing a centralized training program which we hope will be operational in 2007. Of course, with a centralized training program it would be necessary for athletes to relocate, but we are hopeful that all of our athletes would see the obvious benefits of the program.

We are faced with several large decisions, among them the need to employ a National Coach full time or a High Performance Manager with the skills to be able to implement our plans. We are still to work out how this can be funded, without impeding our current commitments to our National teams.

On the competitive front, our national senior teams competed at the World Teams Championships, Commonwealth Championships and Oceania Championships, while our junior Boys and Girls teams competed at the Oceania Championships and World Junior Championships. Australia dominated the Oceania Championships, including wins to Miao Miao and William Henzell in the Women's and Men's Singles respectively. The results at the Commonwealth Championships indicate that our players are competitive at this level, which will make for an interesting tournament at the 2006 Commonwealth Games in Melbourne.

The major tournament for table tennis in 2004 was, of course, the Athens Olympics. Australia qualified six athletes to compete at the Games – Jian Fang Lay, Miao Miao, William Henzell, Russell Lavale, Trevor Brown and David Zalcberg – and recorded some of our best results at this level. Jian, Miao and William all won their first round singles matches, while William and David defeated highly ranked opponents in their first round doubles match.

This year several of our High Performance squad members have played in overseas Pro Tour tournaments which were fully funded, and this is a further effort from the High Performance Committee to provide as many opportunities as possible to compete in big match play.

Finally, congratulations to Kyle Davis, our current Junior U16 & U18 champion, who was chosen as one of 5 junior players world wide to be the recipient of an ITTF Butterfly scholarship for US\$8000.

Annual Australian championships were spread across the nation during 2004 and most were reasonably well attended which is a demonstration of their popularity. Of course, it would great to see a higher attendance at most of these events and it would be even better if representation from all states and territories was present at all.

As has been the practice for many years the Youth Championships were conducted in Victoria (Melbourne) immediately following the Victorian Easter Classic tournaments.

Queensland hosted the Australian Senior Championships for the second year in succession when this tournament was staged at Brisbane's stadium located at Windsor.

The 21st Australian Veterans Championships were played in the national capital and it was certainly good to see the ACT Association take on such a huge challenge.

Another challenging assignment was taken on by WATTA with the successful organisation of the well attended Australian Junior Championships at Joondalup, north of Perth.

The only 'national' that struggled for interest was the Australian Schools Championship which was played in Victoria. Whilst some recommendations have been made for potential improvements the Board would dearly like to be convinced that there is a successful formula 'out there' somewhere. Unfortunately this event has never reached any great heights, and it is considered by some that unless the sport is seriously taken on board within schools across the nation it may not.

The 2004 national tournament calendar was quite busy and when one takes into account the various events on hand within states and territories it appears that the average Table Tennis player would have no excuses for not being able to find some fine sporting action.

The calendar for 2005 has been in place for a while now and has been well publicised, while TTA is currently looking at the 2006 model. Of course, next year is shaping as another tough one as it is a Commonwealth Games year - and the Games are at Melbourne. In addition, it is Australia's 'turn' to conduct both the Oceania Championships and the Oceania World Junior Circuit Event. Shortly all states/territories will be requested to consider expressing an expression of interest in conducting such important events.

The Board has been working quite hard on developing an Operational Plan which is intended to take the sport in this country into the next era. Apart from this huge exercise, the Regulations for National Championships have been under review for a while. A lot of elements from these activities, as well as other contemporary alterations to existing requirements, may impact on national events and national representation.

- 1. The Athletes with Disabilities (AWD) program has continued to grow and prosper, in no small measure because of the significant financial and philosophical support of the TTA Board.
- 2. The first TTA AWD championships in 2003 attracted 37 entrants while the 2004 event drew 57. The increases were across the board but also because of the addition of a new group, the Deaf. It is hoped to include Vision Impaired in 2006 and also to organise the first Open event in that same year.
- 3.The Australian Sports Commission has awarded TTA funding from its project CONNECT \$40,000 in year 1 and \$60,000 in year 2. This project is designed for grass-roots development by removing barriers which will result in the inclusion of AWDs in our membership. To further this project a TTA national implementation committee (NIC) has been established. Qld, NSW, ACT, Vic, SA and WA have joined this committee. Tas hopes to join soon. NT has not answered either invitation.

NIC members have verbally reported significant advances and these will be further outlined at a national meeting in Canberra on 12/13 March – eg, 2 VMs have now included wheelchair rules as a requirement in all their domestic competitions; 2 VMs are now running AWD championships.

(With regard to the inclusion of wheelchair rules, several European countries have already adopted this policy, and the ITTF has drawn up motions for this purpose to be presented at their 2005 AGM.)

- 4. An AWD newsletter has been produced which now incorporates Officials as well.
- 5. Six classifiers have been trained by international instructors. We have joined the Aust Sports Commission (ASC) in a national classification project.
- 6. The Australian Paralympic Committee (APC) has invited TTA into its Paralympic Preparation Program. This invitation includes significant funding in addition to APC guidance and assistance to prepare our High Performance AWDs for Beijing 2008, and beyond.
- 7. As part of project CONNECT requirements the TTA Board detailed its commitment to the development of the AWD program. This is a definitive document.
- 8. The manager of the program would like to thank the members of the AWD committee, the members of the NIC, the TTA Board and Staff, the Boards of committed VMs, the ASC, CONNECT case manager Lynn Phillips, the APC, the classification group, the Officials (tournaments), TTNSW Board and members (tournaments), our partners AUSRAPID, Aust Athletes with Disabilities and Deaf Sports Aust, and the many many individuals who have assisted the development of the program.

Our annual "Thank You" to Margaret Reid (formerly Senator Reid) for her continued role as Patron of our Association. Her continued very strong support was in evidence at the hosting (by our Association) of the 2004 21st Australian Veterans Open Table Tennis Championships, where she officially opened the event and presented medals on the Finals' Day.

Membership:

We had a very slight dip in membership numbers in 2004, from 316 to 298. More of a levelling out after the incredible 21% increase of the previous year. But this still leaves our Association running out of room at our present Kingston Table Tennis Centre. We are pursuing different options at this time to further our playing area if possible.

Department of Sport & Recreation Grant:

Coaching Program:

Athletes with Disabilities Program in Schools - Arthur Wilks:

Arthur (assisted by Zak Kozakiewicz, Glenys Joliffe and Mary Costa) ran a program for disabled students from Lyneham High School on a weekly basis throughout the school year. This program which was originated by Arthur has been in progress since 2001. The young students who attend are highly enthusiastic (which is very rewarding) and are strongly supported by their Teacher, Greg, and Teacher's Assistant, Ros. Also we hosted an A.C.T. Schools Championship which was held for Athletes with Disabilities. In August a small team of students, representing the A.C.T. and their School travelled up to Sydney to compete in the Athletes with Disabilities Australian Championships.

Congratulations to Arthur on great organising and running of the Athletes with Disabilities Australian Championships, which, for the second year since its inauguration, turned out to be a great success.

Congratulations to Patrick Horne, from our Association's 'C' Grade Comp) – his details are as follows:

- a Silver Medal to Patrick, who came 2nd in the Men's (Class 6-10) Singles Event;
- a Gold Medal to Patrick who came 1st in the Men's (Class 6-10) Doubles Event; and to students from Lyneham High School:
 - a Bronze Medal to Jamie-Lee Kelly who came 3rd in the Women's Class 11 Singles;

- 4th placing to Kate Wade in the Women's Class 11 Singles; and

 a Silver Medal to Jamie-Lee Kelly and Kate Wade who came were came 2nd in the Women's Class 11 Doubles..

This program is continuing this year.

Table Tennis Australia Coaching Course:

Zak Kozakiewicz and Mohammed Al Hassan attended a course run in Melbourne in August last year. The course was restricted to only 24 participants. The information gained at any courses are always beneficial to the Association and is passed on to other coaches and players, and also enhances the experience of those who attend.

Other -

Thank you to Dong Dong Zhang (assisted with Junior Squad coaching), and Mohammed Al Hassan who have also been involved in general coaching throughout the year and we thank them for their time and commitment.

A big thank you to all those involved in coaching during 2004. Your continued support is much appreciated.

Table Tennis A.C.T. Courses:

Level 1 Coaching Course:

This Course (15, 16 and 23 May) was very successfully run (by Arthur Wilks and Dong Dong Zhang.

We will be getting the follow-up Course material soon and inviting the participants, who have not already finished off the work, to a group session to finalise the Course. There were 7 people in attendance for the Course.

Level 2 Umpiring Course:

This Course was held on Saturday, 31 July, and Sunday 2 August, being run by Arthur Wilks and Maurie Poole (a guest from New South Wales). There were 6 people in attendance for the Course.

Canberra Grammar - Terms 2 and 3 Courses:

We continued our Coaching Program with Canberra Grammar School last year, running courses in Terms 2 and 3 from 4.00-5.00p.m. There are usually approximately 12 students per session. The students are transported by School bus to the sessions, accompanied by one of the School's teachers.

Zak (assisted by Glenys Joliffe and Wendy Olsen), ran the Courses on Tuesdays and Thursdays, as an after school program.

This kind of program is an essential component of our Association tapping into young people with a view to introducing them to table tennis, enhancing their skills and encouraging them to join up with our Association.

2004 Australian Open Veterans Table Tennis Championships:

The A.I.S. pulled out of its agreement to be our host for this event last year. They sent me correspondence (in February) advising me that their athletes were unable to be off the courts for that length of period. Apparently on the back of the agreement there is a piece indicating that the A.I.S. has the authority to do this if they deem it to be necessary.

It was a quick race around town as there were only about 3 other suitable premises. It turned out that the A.C.T. Netball Centre, just along from the corner of Mouat Street and Northbourne Avenue was the only venue available to us who were in a position to put their regular program forward. A very big thank you to them.

This was an incredibly busy and stressful time – attempting to get everything up and going in preparation for the Championships and I wish to thank Zak and my husband for their unflagging support.

I am very happy to report that we hosted a very successful Championships with 286 participants, accompanied by officials and supported by family/friends. It was the biggest and most successful Australian Veterans Championships held since its inception in 1984.

We have had incredibly positive feedback from many of the players and officials regarding the whole event, which is extremely rewarding.

2004 was a very productive year for Table Tennis NSW.

We gained eight new affiliated associations/clubs -

Table Tennis NSW also held a Level one coaching course presented by Joe Hoad from SA there were 24 participants and to date 14 have completed the course requirements and attained level one coaching status – NSW also had eight representatives attend a level 2 coaching seminar in Melbourne for a week, presented by Table Tennis Australia – 4 have completed the level 2 requirements - very promising for the coaching ranks.

2004 was our 3rd year at Sydney Olympic Park – Sports Halls and again in good partnership with the State Sports Centre Trust

We look forward to re-introducing the TOPS program in 2005 - offering both Bronze & silver.

The venue was open Tuesdays from 7pm to 9 pm for training & coaching - Paul Zhao the on duty coach

On Thursday nights the Metropolitan / Insurance Competition has expanded even further – it is good to see more & more junior teams and players participating in one of the two grades. The competition also includes novice players & coaching. Congratulation to Les Walczuk for his continued organisation & success of this competition – this comp will recommence on Thursday 3rd February 2005.

The City Vs Country annual challenge was again a very enjoyable & successful day with City this year being victorious

In 2004 NSW had the venue for one national championships run by Table Tennis Australia:

1) Australian Athletes with Disabilities Championships – this was the 2nd annual championships held at the Olympic Park Sports Halls and ran over three days – a very successful championships conducted by Table Tennis Australia – with an enormous assistance from NSW volunteers – Kogarah RSL – Douglas Flood, Edd Nash & members as well as the NSW Disabilities Director – Beryl Davies & the Volunteers from the NSW Veterans Association.

The 2004 Tournaments took on a new look with the tournament director using a different computerised draw for all tournaments – the same which is used for National Veterans Championships - this still highlight a few problem areas, which will be rectified in 2005 – we have booked additional area (the middle zone) for Junior &

Veterans - Open & Closed Tournaments as well as the Metropolitan Open, this will allow up to 28 tables for singles round robin matches.

The NSW Schools tournaments were also successful with the new Schools Director Andrew Roden having packed stadiums for most events. Andrew was well assisted by Tien Quach & Wendy Au. Tien organised an early closing date for each event which allowed draws to be timed and forwarded to each school in advance, this proved extremely successful. Andrew formed sub committees with the teachers, providing valuable feedback

Our representative teams for 2004 have once again had excellent performances.

A total of 30 representative teams at National Championships, which is an outstanding effort.

Also the monthly veterans Pennant commences Sunday 13th February with five grades and 34 teams

Both teams' competitions have increased teams competing on the 2004 numbers

NSW will be hosting two National Championships for 2005

Australian – Senior Open Championships – 1st – 5th August – Olympic Park – Sports Halls

NORTHERN TERRITORY TABLE TENNIS ASSOCIATION REPORT Mr. John Pudney

Northern Territory activity remained relatively stable over the past twelve months with continued involvement from the same loyal volunteers as the previous year.

In Alice Springs another very successful Masters Games was held during October (held every two years and promoted by the Northern Territory Government) ,a great effort by event coordinator Graeme Shaughnessy and the Alice Springs Table Tennis Association.

The Darwin Based competition has been trialing two person team competitions and has now extended this into 2005 for all evening grades.

Total Player numbers have remained stable with a small but welcome increase in junior participation.

Territory Government Sponsorship has been limited during this period, due in part to the reduced level of major events. NTTTA remains hopeful for Government support of a proposed development officer to provide a further catalyst to programs in the NT .Funding has been earmarked by the association to assist.

The NT has invested time in further strategic development with initiation of a new constitution and completion of a 5 year business plan.

Commencement of formal Table Tennis Activity in Palmerston and Katherine is a goal for 2005.

The association is looking forward to hosting the 2005 Arafura Games in May 2005 and the National Veterans in September.

I would like to thank the board members of TTQ for their hard work and dedication to the advancement of Table Tennis in Queensland. The work of all volunteers in clubs from the Presidents to the canteen workers is essential in providing the necessary environment for future success. The volunteers in clubs are not recognized nearly enough for their commitment and effort so I take this opportunity to thank each and every one of you, as I know from experience your work is rarely applauded. I continue to urge each club to try to improve our membership base. With more members we increase our pool of volunteers and bring fresh ideas to our sport.

Once again Queensland hosted the National Championships with BTTA being the host association. Everyone I talked to was impressed by the opening ceremony and the following events. Queensland players gained great results with the Ladies team gaining a silver medal and the Men's team a bronze.

Sue Stevenson was appointed director of coaching this year and has held coaching camps for juniors and seniors as well as conducting coaching courses to improve the standard and delivery of coaching to our players. Most clubs now have at least a level one coach and some coaching structure, which can only improve the standard of table tennis in Queensland.

Rockhampton held the Queensland juniors this year with many clubs represented from throughout Queensland. While the job of running this event is very demanding, by all reports was conducted very successfully by the Rockhampton club. Because Queensland is so vast we need the support of clubs to conduct these events and bring our players together as much as possible. I urge all members to support the club open tournaments in 2005.

The National Junior Championships were held in Perth and Table Tennis Queensland sent many teams and a staff of 4 coaches and a chaperone. Queensland gained a gold medal in the U18 girl's team's event and Claire Campbell-Innes a gold in the individual U18 girls event. Claire was also awarded the player of the tournament award. The most encouraging aspect of these championships was the number of young players representing for the first time who gained experience from the event and will no doubt perform much better next year due to their exposure to this standard of play.

There are many new initiatives planned by the TTQ Board for 2005 and all are designed to:

- Improve Table Tennis Queensland's delivery of service to members;
- Develop closer relationships between clubs and with TTQ to enable sharing of skills and knowledge;
- Gain better results in interstate competitions; and
- Improve the standard and number players.

Over the past three years the Board has been working towards taking more responsibility for the way development has been handled in Queensland with more emphasis on using organizational funds effectively to gain the best results for all members. With the help and support of clubs in these new initiatives we can all look forward to a more successful year in 2005 and our success growing every year.

Table Tennis Australia would like to thank The Australian Commonwealth Games Association



for their support of our High Performance Program through their funding for the Target 2006 Program.

With the generous assistance of the Australian Commonwealth Games Association our players will be aiming for Gold at the 2006 Commonwealth Games in Melbourne.

While contemplating my report for this year I reread my 2003 report and found that I had failed to achieve one of my prime goals for 2004 which was to visit as many affiliates as possible in order to obtain feedback from them on the problems they and TTSA are facing. In fact I have only visited two affiliates during the year at their invitation and despite requests to several other affiliates for a meeting it is unfortunate that these meetings have not taken place.

I consider it important to open the lines of communication between TTSA and it's members so that both parties can be aware of the needs of the other. We are continuing to play the game of withholding player registrations from the state association presumably to save money at the affiliate level or to placate those players who object to paying this fee. Any player who objects to paying a registration fee to TTSA does not have the best interests of table tennis in mind and any affiliate who encourages this attitude is not acting in the best interests of the sport.

In order for everybody to understand the financial affairs of TTSA I have prepared a pared down analysis which attempts to show where your dollars are being spent. This analysis shows that we do very well in some areas with the limited funds that are available to us but we are found wanting in the area of promotion of the sport. This situation will continue until we are able to establish good communications with the affiliates and work with them to achieve a higher profile for table tennis. Administrators at affiliate level must acknowledge that promotion and development of the sport starts with them in conjunction with TTSA and TTA.

I recently attended a TTA meeting in Sydney which dealt with the development of a strategic plan for TTA. This plan is designed to cover all areas of the sport from administration through to umpires and referees. The next stage is to prepare an operational plan and presumably an organisational chart which will designate areas of responsibility for various directors or committees who will be responsible for the implementation of the plan. This plan is being prepared under the auspices of the Australian Sports Commission and is a necessary step to maintain the funding currently being received by TTA from the ASC. The plan is also a necessary and vital step being taken by TTA towards the future development of the sport and I applaud their efforts thus far. TTSA will certainly be looking in more detail at the outcome as a possible model for use at state level.


The Board has given approval to the formation of a sub-committee to promote and develop junior and youth table tennis at the state level. In recent years SA has slipped from it's perch at the top of junior table tennis to this year having trouble forming teams. This committee will consist of various parents of junior players (at this stage it is Dennis Karamalikis, Greg Dobrovic and David Moffatt) and will be reporting to me as President. This group has been working for the last few years doing fund raising on behalf of the team members and succeeded in raising enough money to fund team captains/coaches to travel with the teams. It is intended that their area of responsibility be sponsorship, coaching and management with all recommendations to be approved by the Board.

I would like to thank all members of the board for their help and hard work during the year particularly Geoff Goss, Cynthia Langley and John Potter who collectively cover the most important portfolios and are tireless in their efforts on behalf of table tennis. I would also

give a special mention to Su Le who has taken on the task of Publicity & Promotions primarily working to establish our web site which is very much a work in progress and I hope that Su will continue in 2005.

I would also like to thank all members of the various sub-committees who have contributed their time to assist in the various tasks that need to be done especially state selectors and those who have helped with tournaments.

I hope you all have a very merry Christmas and a not too jolly, but very enjoyable, new year and wish you all the best for the coming year in table tennis.

TASMANIAN TABLE TENNIS ASSOCIATION REPORT

My impression of 2004 for table tennis in Tasmania is that it was one of "treading water". Sadly Eastside experienced a sharp decline in numbers from those of 2003. On an encouraging note, some additional events were included in several of the open tournaments and these were well received by the players.

STTTA continued its junior coaching programme this year again utilising grant funds from Sport & Recreation Tasmania. This undertaking was once again a success.

State League was once again successfully staged by the Northern Tasmanian Table Tennis Association using the Launceston Country Club Casino as the venue. I thank David Cramp for heading up the organization of this event.

Preparation work is underway for the 2006 National Veterans Championships which will be staged in Hobart.

Congratulations to the Eastside Table Tennis League, our youngest branch, which celebrates its 25 years of operation.

I wish to record my thanks and appreciation to the TTTA Board members for their contributions during 2004. As Chairman I count myself fortunate to have Directors who are highly capable in carrying out the duties under their portfolios. Thank you to Bill Atkinson for his continued attention to National Affairs, Maureen Sherman for keeping us all up to scratch on technical matters, Doug McLean for his excellent work in keeping our website up to date and getting us media coverage wherever possible, Elaine Wright for attending to the administration portfolio as well as taking on responsibility for the finances.

I also thank the Branches and the Branch Delegates for their attention to matters raised during 2004.

It is with great sadness and a sense of loss that I formally record the death of our Director of Finance, Margaret Turner in July 2004. Margaret will be greatly missed by all who knew and worked with her in table tennis. This is especially true of her fellow TTTA Board members.

Looking forward to 2005, I believe that this year will be a very important one for the future of table tennis as a sport in Tasmania. As it stands the sport is in grave danger of downgrading itself from "sport" to "recreation". If we wish to keep the "sport" designation then there is much work to do to rebuild our numbers of players, administrators, coaches and umpires. It will take several years, at least, and will require a collective vision and will to act together which we have not had in the last seven years.

Our work in rebuilding will be hampered by the financial burden placed on us by the TTA levies. Tasmania has attempted to have the system changed for over 15 years. Yet it still remains unchanged. Our percentage of the National total player numbers has declined from 5.7% in 2001 to 3.97%. Based on the current "frozen percentage" system this will cost us around an extra \$1,500 this year. This is money which we can ill afford. It may be that our best plan is to withdraw from TTA as our branches already see little benefit from our affiliation with it. Of course this would have a knock on effect to TTA as its Australian Sports Commission Grants would be difficult to obtain if it no longer had national coverage of the sport.

2004 was a challenging year for all at Table Tennis Victoria. I returned to the position of CEO in late May 2004.

TTV Board of Management:

The Board composition altered a number of times during the year with the resignation of a Board member and the inclusion of a new one. Ron Keyhoe resigned as Members Portfolio Holder. The Board welcomed Vick Buff as Junior Portfolio holder. Alan Hopkins was returned to the position of Treasurer for another term.

2004 Tournaments:

It was a busy year on the 2004 Tournament Calendar with Victoria hosting the Australian Youth Championships, as well as a number of tournaments hosted by TTV and our Affiliates. Nationally, at the Youth Championships Victoria took first place in both the Men's & Women's Teams event and performed well in the Individual events. Kyle Davis won the Australian Youth Men's Championships Singles Title, partnered Andy Shih to take the Men's Doubles and was runner-up with Mimi Lee in the Mixed Doubles, with both he & Mimi being named the STIGA Best Players and Number One on the Order of Merit. Victoria also celebrated outstanding results at the Australian Veterans, Seniors & Juniors Championships in 2004. In particular Russell Lavale and Miao Miao won the Mens and Womens Australian Seniors Singles Titles, the Mens and Womens Australian Doubles Titles and teamed to win the Australian Mixed Doubles Title.

Locally Simon Gerada captured his sixth straight Victorian Open Men's Singles title. He partnered David Zalcberg to take the Mens Double Title also. Internationally Victoria was well represented on both the Men's and Women's Table Tennis Teams at the Athens Olympics by Russell Lavale, Trevor Brown, David Zalcberg, Miao Miao, and Jian Fang Lay.

The 2005 Tournament Calendar guarantees to be another challenging year for Victoria. TTV we will be hosting the Australian Junior Championships, The Australian Youth Championships and building up to the Commonwealth Games in early 2006. Add The Victorian Open and The Country Championships to the above and we are guaranteed to see some great Table Tennis during the year.

TTV Finances:

Financially many of our Clubs and Associations have reported successful years. This can't be said for the State Body however. In returning to the role of CEO, one of the areas identified for improvement was our financial performance which has continued to be area of concern for TTV. While we were able to make an improvement in the 7 months I was in the role in 2004, the result was still a \$17k loss for the year compared to \$25k in 2003.

In order to turn things around TTV conducted a survey of all other states registration fees as well as other sports. TTV found that the fees were too low for the size of our Membership. A decision was made to increase our fees significantly to be more in line with sports our size. Importantly our Affiliates have supported this decision and 2005 should be the first year where tough decisions such as this start to show the benefits.

Alois Rosario (Sports Development Officer) resigned after 18 years at TTV to start his own business. Alois still assists TTV when required. At this stage TTV has not replaced Alois as we re-establish ourselves financially.

Thanks:

Finally, TTV would like to thank all the volunteers who have helped throughout the year. Without them we would not be able to offer such great programs and the infrastructure needed to be able provide our members with so many playing opportunities. In order for TTV to move forward in 2005 we will see many changes and we look forward to working with our volunteers to meet the challenge.

WESTERN AUSTRALIAN TABLE TENNIS ASSOCIATION REPORT

Mr. Irwin Parker

Again in 2004 all Board of Management positions were filled. Bob Lake continued as Administratition Manager and Frank Kenny as Development Officer. Those who continued in their 2003 positions were Brian Lauri (President), Dave Cooper (Match Director & Tournament Director), Irwin Parker (Finance Director), Penelope Whitby (Social & Fund Raising) and Charles Crock (Coaching Director) while Frank Kenny took on the position of Publicity & Promotions Director.

Overall membership remained stagnant, although overall participation levels—showed an increase as illustrated by an overall increase in tournament entries. These were healthy, in particular the State Open Championship that attracted a record 107 entries. Also the recently formed Fremantle club revived the Fremantle Open after a break of over 20 years. The Esperance club helped maintain the momentum of a successful string of country tournaments. Geraldton will host this year's event after a ten-year gap.

As usual the Association offered pennant competitions for Summer, Winter, Spring and Veterans with the numbers of teams more or less unchanged from 2003. It seems that the desire to compete in these competitions is declining over the years, possibly due to the aging of the player population. All competitions ran smoothly in part due the continuation of the duty referee system.

The Association Junior Development program, sponsored by Healthway with assistance from the Department of Sport & Recreation, continued on from previous years. A great deal of association coaching effort was directed toward the preparation of teams for the National Junior Championships. A highlight of the year was the visit, under the Alcoa Coach in Residence scheme, of Mark Smith a level 3 ETTA coach. Very successful coaching sessions were complimented by a "Challenge" invitation tournament, which Mark won.

For the first time in a number of years, Western Australia was well represented at all National Championships. The staging of the National Junior Championship provided a number of Junior players with the opportunity to be blooded in national competition. Congratulations are extended to Nicole Low in being Nationally ranked in three age groups. Organisational wise the event was a great success under the guidance of first time chairperson Sue Brown. Additionally the event made a profit of approximately \$4,500 thus financing capital expenditure on the acquisition of new equipment.

The Association made a \$5073 profit in the year ended 30 September 2004 mainly as result of the profit made on the conduct of the Australian Junior Championships. Also an additional \$3,000 assistance was allocated to the event by the Department of Sport and Recreation otherwise an overall loss of \$3,000 would have been incurred. Centre gross income rose by over 7% but this was more than offset by the \$5,200 cost of resurfacing the floor. Additionally the Association incurred over \$9,000 in capital expenditure, the court surrounds and a photocopier accounting for most of this expenditure.
