#### PRESIDENT'S REPORT

It has been another very busy year for Table Tennis Australia. At the international level, our players competed in a number of important junior, senior and veterans' events. On the home front, National Championships catering for age divisions from Under 14 to Over 70 were conducted in various States. In addition, Table Tennis Australia has been involved in numerous matters relating to officiating and coaching, but I shall leave the reporting of those matters to the respective Board members responsible for those portfolios.

In June 2002, an Australian Under 18 Girls' Team participated in the Youth World Festival in Hungary. The Festival was held in conjunction with the World Cadet (Under 15) Challenge, in which an Oceania Boys' Team and an Oceania Girls' Team participated. Three of the four members of the Oceania Boys' Team were Australian players, and, similarly, three of the four members of the Oceania Girls' Team were Australian players. All of the Teams were managed by our Chief Executive Officer Matty Padley.

Also in June 2002, a number of Australian players participated in the World Veterans' Championships in Switzerland. Our outstanding competitor was Betty Bird, who won a Gold medal in the Over 60 Women's Doubles Event and a Bronze medal in the Over 60 Women's Singles Event.

In July 2002, Australian Men's, Women's, Under 20 Men's, Under 20 Women's, Under 17 Boys' and Under 17 Girls' Teams participated in the Oceania Championships in Fiji. Australian Teams won 4 of the 6 teams events. In addition, all of the individual events in which Australian players participated were won by Australian players, with the exception of the Under 14 Boys' Doubles (in which we had only one competitor). Our outstanding competitors were Russell Lavale, who won a gold medal in each of the Men's Open Singles, the Men's Open Doubles and the Mixed Open Doubles Events, Jian Fang Lay, who won a gold medal in each of the Women's Open Singles, the Women's Open Doubles and the Women's Teams Events, and John Tawadrous, who won a gold medal in each of the Under 20 Men's Singles, the Under 20 Men's Doubles, the Under 20 Men's Teams, the Under 17 Boys' Singles and the Under 17 Boys' Doubles Events.

In July-August 2002, an Australian Team (Men, Women and Women's Wheelchair) competed in the Commonwealth Games in Manchester. The Games proved to be an outstanding success for our players and we exceeded most people's expectations by winning 4 medals: viz, silver by our Women's Team in the Women's Teams Event, silver by Brett Clarke and Jian Fang Lay in the Mixed Doubles Event, bronze by Miao Miao and Jian Fang Lay in the Women's Doubles Event and bronze by Joy Boyd in the Women's Wheelchair Singles Event.

In August-September 2002, Miao Miao participated in the Women's World Cup in Singapore as Oceania's representative.

In October 2002, many Australian players participated in the World Masters Games in Melbourne and numerous medals were won by Australians.

In October-November 2002, Russell Lavale competed in the Men's World Cup in China as Oceania's representative.

On the domestic scene, the following National Championships were successfully conducted this year:

- in March, the Australian Youth Championships were conducted by Table Tennis Victoria in Melbourne;
- (b) in July, the Australian Senior Championships were conducted by the Western Australian Table Tennis Association in Perth;

- (c) in September-October, the Australian Junior Championships were conducted by Table Tennis Victoria in Melbourne; and
- in October, the Australian Veterans' Championships were conducted by Table Tennis Victoria in Melbourne.

I thank Table Tennis Victoria and the Western Australian Table Tennis Association for their sterling efforts in hosting those Championships.

Unfortunately, the National Schools' Championships, which were due to be held in Victoria, were cancelled by the Organising Committee due to lack of entries. These Championships are very important for the development of the game in Australia and we must endeavour to ensure that these Championships are not cancelled again.

In January 2003, the Australian Youth Olympic Festival was held in Sydney. Fourteen Olympic sports participated in the Festival, including table tennis. The purpose of the Festival was to provide young, aspiring athletes with the chance to experience what it is like to be an Olympian. The table tennis competition was limited to those athletes born between 1 January 1985 and 31 December 1988 inclusive. Two Australian Boys' Teams and two Australian Girls' Teams participated in the table tennis competition. In addition, the Oceania Boys' and Girls' Teams each contained an Australian athlete. Australian athletes did very well, both in the teams events and the individual events. In the Boys' Teams Event, the Australian Team of John Tawadrous and Andy Shih won the silver medal. In the Girls' Teams Event, the Australian Team of Claire Campbell-Innes and Michelle Beaumont won the bronze medal. In the Boys' Doubles Event, John Tawadrous and Andy Shih won the silver medal. In the Girls' Doubles Event, Claire Campbell-Innes and Michelle Beaumont won the silver medal. The Organising Committee of the table tennis competition, consisting of Matty Padley (Competition Director), Neil Harwood (Event Organiser) and Graeme Ireland (Referee), were widely and deservedly congratulated for their efforts and I thank them for the same.

There is an increasing number of opportunities for our junior players to participate in international junior competition. Provided that our national junior players are nurtured properly, the experience which they gain from international junior competition should auger well for our future national senior teams.

One inevitable consequence of the increase in our participation in international competition at junior and senior levels is an increase in the workload of our National Selectors and our National Coaches. I thank them all for their endeavours. The increase in our participation in international competition also inevitably increases the workload of our Chief Executive Officer and the Board of Management. I thank Matty and my fellow Board members for their efforts, not only in relation to the international arena, which only represents a proportion of our workload (some Board members would say too large a proportion), but in all areas of administration.

At the time of the compilation of this report, the audit of our financial statements for the year ending 31 December 2002 has not been completed. However, our financial position now appears to be sound. At the commencement of the financial year ending 31 December 2000, we had an accumulated deficit of \$75,472.00. By the end of that financial year, we had reduced the accumulated deficit to \$19,497.00. By the end of the financial year ending 31 December 2001, we had eliminated the accumulated deficit altogether and created an accumulated surplus of \$3,013.00. The likelihood is that by the end of the financial year ending 31 December 2002, our accumulated surplus will have increased.

In the penultimate paragraph of my report to the 2002 Annual General Meeting, I commented that although in the periods immediately preceding and succeeding the formation of the Interim Board of Management in May 2000 the States and Territories were

largely united, over the 12 months preceding the 2002 AGM there had been occasions when there had been a return to State parochialism and/or personal agendas and that if table tennis was to advance at a national level in Australia, then it was important that we all keep the national interest uppermost in our minds. That comment is equally relevant today. One of my major concerns is the spreading of unsubstantiated and inaccurate information, which is then uncritically accepted by the recipients of that information. This inevitably results in unnecessary acrimony and detracts from our efforts to advance the national interest.

Over the next 12-24 months, a number of important administrative positions are likely to become available at a national and international level. It is important that we not only choose wisely in this regard, but that we also encourage wisely, i.e. that we encourage appropriate persons to nominate for these positions. There are those who need table tennis and there are those whom table tennis needs. Of course, some persons fall into both categories and some persons fall into neither category. However, many persons fall into one but not the other category. It is important that we encourage those persons who fall into the latter category to come forward and make themselves available for service.

I am pleased to report that in 2002 we have had a number of wins in a variety of areas.

Firstly, and probably most importantly, our registration numbers increased by a total of 815 members. This is the first time since 1995 that we have seen an increase, and I hope that it is the start of a very positive trend. The result can be attributed to a strong team effort by most Voting Members with only SA having a negative result. I hope that during the planned 'Towards the Future' Seminar, which is to be held prior to the 2003 AGM, some of the successful methods for increasing membership numbers can be shared and developed even further to help us continue in this positive direction.

Again, in the coaching area we have broken the decline and ended the year with a 16% increase on last year's figures. A number of States/Territories have been eagerly waiting for new courses to be accredited and we intend to arrange for presenters to visit and conduct courses in the very near future. My congratulations go to Queensland, Victoria and South Australia who have started the new year well having already commenced their recruitment process and actively encourage those whose registration has expired, or is near expiry, to re-register.

Our officials have continued to operate in their usual efficient manner. Following the success of their Level 1 recruitment drive of 2001, they have this year completed the conversion of the old State Umpires to the new Level 2 NOAS. I must also make a special mention of the proactive group in Queensland who continued to recruit NEW umpires adding another 31 to their Level 1 list this year.

When talking about wins, one cannot ignore the successes of our Commonwealth Games Athletes and my congratulations go to all the team members. Although I am a firm believer that 'participation' is the most positive aspect of any sport, it cannot be ignored that to win medals definitely adds a degree of prestige to a sport's recognition, particularly in the eyes of the general public and media. To all those who dedicate their lives, striving to reach this level of greatness, I applaud your dedication and commitment, and thank you on behalf of our sport for your contribution to its development.

The Commonwealth Games included for the first time events for Athletes with a Disability. Table Tennis was invited to send two female wheelchair athletes one of whom returned home with a bronze medal. This is a great start to the introduction of a new, formal TTA committee whose aim is to develop the opportunities for physically and intellectually challenged table tennis players. My thanks go to Arthur Wilks who has taken the initiative to co-ordinate this on a National scale.

2002 also saw the introduction of a wonderful new international junior development programme – the ITTF Junior Circuit. I was privileged to have been selected by the Oceania Table Tennis Federation to act as the Team Manager for the Oceania Team to participate in the inaugural 'Cadet Challenge' which was held in Hungary, 10-16 June. This was a truly amazing experience where the teams comprised of representatives of the Continents rather than members of the same country. Imagine witnessing a team made up of representatives from China, Korea, Japan and Taipei all working together, supporting each other. A truly innovative idea from the ITTF and one that we should definitely support in the future.

Immediately following the Cadet Challenge our players also took part in the 4<sup>th</sup> Youth Table Tennis World Festival. Again, this was a sight to behold with players from all over Europe joining the Cadets to compete in four days of intensive competition. The eagerness of these athletes was a joy to witness. It became a familiar sight to see up to 20 sharing one table for warm ups before the day's competition commenced. How you may ask? Five taking turns in each guarter of the table. Miss a shot and you went to the back of the gueue. No arguments, everyone knew the rules and just focused on keeping the ball on the table as long as possible to get the most out of their turn. Their enthusiasm was most contagious!

The geographical location of our wonderful country has, and always will be, an obstacle that we will have to endure. For this reason we have concentrated on building relations with those nearest our shores. With the assistance of the Australian Junior Commonwealth Games Squad programme, we were able to arrange two training camps/test matches this year in a couple of our neighbouring countries. In January a team of four juniors went to Singapore and in December six went to New Zealand. Both of these camps provided the athletes with intensive training and competition whilst also building stronger relations. I firmly believe that we should continue working with our neighbours, sharing resources and maximising the opportunities that lie on our doorstep.

#### DEVELOPMENT

Unfortunately, in December, the Board Member responsible for our 'Development' portfolio resigned. However, prior to his departure, we had undertaken a programme to promote active membership drives at the club level. Clubs/Associations were contacted and asked to provide us with proposals and innovative ideas of ways they intended to increase their participant numbers. In the beginning our plan was to reward one 'best model' club from each Voting Member. With the thanks of a last minute, bonus 'Development Grant' from the Australian Sports Commission, we were able to award all those clubs who participated in the programme. We are still hoping to receive and collate feedback from these recipients, the information from which we will then circulate nationally.

#### FINANCE

Firstly, I must stress that I am not a Finance Director, and do not hold any such qualifications. Our Finance Director resigned in December 2001 and has not been replaced. We have, however, through 'pulling in the purse strings' and concentrating on the need to provide the organisation with a firm financial base to operate on, managed to clear TTA of all debts and even place us 'in the black'.

Many will look at this and ask, "why do they still need our money?". To those, I ask that you look at the situation in more depth. We have been strongly supported over the past year by the Australian Sports Commission and the Australian Commonwealth Games Association who have allowed us to allocate a percentage of their grant monies to administration costs. However what happens if these monies cease to become available for any number of reasons?

The general income coming from the Voting Members must be sufficient to sustain the running costs of TTA, and we should actually look at building on this, finding ways to increase our income, so that we can develop and become a more professional organisation.

We need to expand as, although we have achieved much, we are not being as effective as we should. There has been a very significant increase in opportunities for international junior participation. This, as well as the proposal to develop our sport in the area of disabilities, substantially increases the workload from the days when we had six staff in the office.

The results reflected in this report are the first steps towards what could be a very promising future.

This portfolio includes four main areas as detailed below.

#### OFFICIATING

- 1. Two conferences were organised in Canberra.
- 2. The level 1 Association umpire course now has 184 graduates.
- The level 2 State umpire course has been written, accredited by the Australian sports Commission, and now has some 45 umpires registered.
- The level 2 course was modified in February to include a section on rules for players in wheelchairs.
- 5. The level 3 umpire course has been written and submitted to the Sports Commission.
- 6. The writing of the National Referee course is well advanced.
- The Officiating newsletter was resurrected after many years with the publication of two editions. The second edition included articles from other areas and this should lead to a new TTA newsletter.
- Graeme Ireland was selected as TTA Official of the Year and he has been shortlisted for the same honour by Sport Industry Australia.

#### ATHLETES WITH DISABILITIES

- 1. In a first the Board allocated a budget for this area in 2002/2003.
- 2. Two committees have been established to carry out foundation work.
- An application for full membership has been submitted to the Australian Paralympic Committee.
- Work has commenced on the writing of a table tennis specific Coaching Athletes with Disabilities (CAD)course.
- Work has commenced on an application for acceptance into the Sports Commission's project CONNECT.
- Work has commenced on the organisation of the first TTA championships for all categories of athletes with disabilities. An invitation to attend has been extended to the international chief classifier.

#### LIAISON

 Have attended possibly 20 meetings at the Australian Sports Commission with regard to Officiating, Coaching, IT, Finance and Funding, appearing in Video, compliance requirements, development of competencies for course writing, Sports Commission/TTA relationships, Development.

#### MISCELLANEOUS

- 1. Assisted the CEO for 12 days.
- 2. Represented TTA at various official functions including the Youth Olympics.
- 3. Presented good governance recommendations to Board.
- 4. Carried out early work on the development of a national insurance scheme.

We had the privilege of hosting a visit from an extremely experienced coach this year. In October, Mariann Domonkos, ex Canadian National Coach, visited our shores and agreed to present a two day seminar to a group of our local coaches. The seminar was arranged to fall between the Australian Junior Championships and the World Masters Championships with the hope of attracting coaches from all States. This concept was successful with over half of the 24 attendees being from interstate.

As the skill levels of the participating coaches varied from beginners to recognised Level 3's, the task of presenting to the group proved quite a challenge for Mariann, however she coped with it admirably. Everyone was able to take away with them updated knowledge which hopefully they will not only apply to their own coaching experiences, but will also pass on to their colleagues.

My thanks go to the Coburg Club for providing us with a venue and to Alois Rosario for his assistance in arranging the seminar.

During the Australian Junior Championships we took the opportunity to hold a meeting with a representative from each State/Territory. Our aim is to re-establish the National Coaching Committee (NCC). David Wilson assisted by Chairing the meeting where we outlined the NCC's coaching policies and an update was presented on the current position of the National Coaching Accreditation Scheme (NCAS). It is our intention to hold a formal national seminar annually with the appropriate State/Territory Coaching Directors. The first of these is planned for mid 2003.

Early in 2003 we can look forward to a visit from a Level 4 coach from Sweden, Jan Berner. Jan will be arriving in January for a 5 week visit to 5 states. All airfares are being funded by Olympic Solidarity monies from the ITTF via the OTTF with each State only being responsible for hospitality and ground transport. Jan visited New Zealand earlier this year and from all reports we can expect to gain a lot of current information on coaching techniques and an update on the skills which are currently being practiced internationally.

I would like to thank in advance both the ITTF and the OTTF for their financial support of this great opportunity.

The national calendar of events seems to be becoming more difficult to set each year due to a combination of more international activities than in the past and what appears to be an increase in interest of Australia's elite players in events in other countries.

It has been great to see most of our leading junior players receive some international experience during 2002. I am sure these opportunities will continue to be offered and will result in a higher standard across the nation.

To assist with the achievement of this outcome, the TTA Board is keen to see all of Australia's elite players attend national championships in which they are eligible to play.

The Board takes its responsibility to membership very seriously and most of the contemporary programs are designed to benefit the majority, rather than a minority, from a long term point of view.

To assist with planning, the Board envisages releasing a provisional events calendar for 2004 shortly and publishing same on the TTA website. In the future, the Board intends to post such calendars at least a year in advance in conjunction with the recently developed rotation of national championships.

National championships were successfully conducted during 2002. The concept of combining the Youth Championships with TTV's Easter Classic appeared to be popular with the players once again.

Table Tennis Victoria also hosted the Australian Junior and Veterans' Championships. Considering these carnivals were separated by the World Masters Games it is obvious that officials from Victoria were kept busy.

After quite a few years break, the Western Australian Table Tennis Association successfully organised the Australian Senior Championships.

The only disappointment was the cancellation of the Australian Schools' Championships, which were also scheduled for Victoria, but unfortunately cancelled due to lack of entries. It is hoped that there will be plenty of support for this tournament in 2003 at Homebush, New South Wales.

#### **Glenys Joliffe**

Firstly, our sincere thanks to Senator Margaret Reid again this year for her continued strong support, as our Patron. Senator Reid is retiring from politics, and we wish her all the best for the future. She has always been a tower of strength and we would like to thank her for her contribution, so graciously given, to our Association over the years.

This has been a learning year for a lot of us with the introduction of the games scored 11-up. This was a completely new approach to the game, introduced by the International Federation, thence down through our national body, Table Tennis Australia, thence to all State/Territory Associations. I am pleased to say that our members approached it very positively. It has had an immediate impact on games, which members have endeavoured to incorporate into their approach to matches. It has not always been easy or smooth, but we are learning to live with it.

#### SPONSORSHIP

**Bureau of Sport & Recreation Grant**: A BIG thank you to the Bureau for their continued support with the Triennial Grant Program - we have been guaranteed further funding for another two years. This is essential for our growth as a "small" sport in the A.C.T.

**Dean's Trophy Centre**: Another thank you to Dean's Trophy Centre, Kambah, who kindly through their Manager, Jane, sponsored our State Grade Trophies last year, and for her ever friendly and helpful assistance.

#### INTER-CITIES MATCHES

**Canberra/Goulburn:** Hurrah! We have managed after a lot of discussion to settle on a twice-yearly Monaro Cup Challenge between our two cities. The first of these was held on 5 May in Goulburn, followed up by a return challenge in Canberra early in December. These were greeted enthusiastically by the players with a range of teams entered in the Junior, Senior and Veterans categories. Canberra won the Cup and all players had an enjoyable time in the two overall challenge matches for 2002.

**Canberra/Sydney:** Canberra and Sydney negotiated an inter-city match at the Olympic Stadium at Homebush. We sent 25 teams up there and are hopeful of hosting a return match in 2003. Sydney was successful in the inaugural match, but everyone won as far as having an enjoyable day, which is what our game is all about isn't it.

Canberra/Wagga: During the year Zak coordinated a very successful trip by a number of our members to Wagga - A.C.T. had five representative teams. Results elsewhere in the report. Wagga is interested in a "return" match next year in Canberra.

#### COACHING/PROMOTION

**Development Officer/Coaching Co-ordinator - Zak Kozakiewicz**: Zak ran table tennis coaching in two schools (at St Edmund's College and Canberra Grammar) with able support. Zak has also assisted Arthur Wilks with coaching for disabled students (at Lyneham High) and provided coaching for our Association members on request.

**Disabled Program - Arthur Wilks:** Arthur ran a program for disabled students from Lyneham High School. Our congratulations to Arthur Wilks - his knowledge, experience and qualifications won him the position of Coach and Manager for the Australian Disabled Table Tennis Team at the 2002 Manchester Commonwealth Games.

**Other**: Dong Dong Zhang and Mohammed Al Hassan have also been involved in coaching. We thank them for their time devoted to the Association. Their expert coaching covers a wide range of members from our Association.

We farewelled a young international table tennis player, Kubah Wankowicz from Poland. His coaching and friendly personality proved very popular at our Centre. He is hopeful of getting approval from the Department of Immigration to return. Our Association would welcome his expertise again if he returns to Australia and the A.C.T.

The efforts of all who contributed with coaching during 2002 are very highly valued and very much appreciated.

#### **REPRESENTATIVE TEAMS - AUSTRALIAN CHAMPIONSHIPS**

In 2002 we have had teams/representatives attending the Australian Junior, Under 18 and the National Veterans' Championships.

Full details of teams and Australian rankings are shown elsewhere in this report. Three of our players received Australian Rankings.

#### WORLD CADET CHALLENGE

Geoff Chan was chosen in the Oceanic Team to play at the World Cadet Challenge Championships held in Hungary. Our congratulations to Geoff, a great opportunity for him to experience international match play.

#### LIFE MEMBERSHIP

Jeff Plumb was awarded Life Membership of our Association. The award was very proudly accepted by his parents. They read out a personal thank you message from Jeff, who is at present overseas with his wife.

#### NEW SOUTH WALES COUNTRY CHAMPIONSHIPS

Our Association hosted the Championships on the Queen's Birthday weekend in June 2002 at the Southern Cross Stadium, at Tuggeranong, and it was an enormous success.

There were a record number (42) of teams entered. All who attended seemed to have an enjoyable weekend.

A big thank you to the N.S.W. Country Association for their organisation/loan of equipment for the tournament.

I am very thrilled to report (details elsewhere in the report) that our Association WON the Trophy for this tournament.

#### A.C.T. RESIDENTS CHAMPIONSHIPS

Our annual tournament was held on the weekend 24-25 November. A BIG thank you to our hard working tournament guru, Rob Crowdy and also to his assistants. The results are elsewhere in this Annual Report.

#### HOSTING OF AUSTRALIAN TABLE TENNIS CHAMPIONSHIPS

#### Graham Symons

NT total registration numbers for 2002 were 105 adults and 22 juniors. Both member associations, the Darwin Table Tennis Association and the Alice Springs Table Tennis Association, successfully managed their 2002 competition programs but have not had the people resources to implement developmental strategies to expand membership. The NT Association applied for NT Government grant assistance to employ a part-time person for 2002-03 to work particularly with primary schools but the application was unsuccessful. The application will be resubmitted for 2003-04.

The NT Open was conducted in Darwin in July 2002 and both the DTTA and the ASTTA conducted local tournaments in 2002.

The NTTA will be running a table tennis tournament as part of the Arafura Games commencing on 16 May 2003. The Arafura Games attracts regional representative teams from China, Hong-Kong, Macau, Thailand, Malaysia, New Zealand and Brunei and provides a high standard of competition. In past games, teams from Victoria, WA, Northern Queensland and SA have participated.



#### SOUTH AUSTRALIA PRESIDENT'S REPORT

I would like to thank all affiliates, players and board members, past and present for their support during my terms of Presidency.

A lot of things have been achieved during that time starting from the top with the TTA Board being removed due to the state of financial deficit. Despite some reservation by some of our members being brought up at different meetings, TTA have now become solvent.

Table Tennis Australia have now regained the credibility of the Australian Olympic Committee, Australian Commonwealth Games Association and the Australian Sports Commission.

TTA has frozen the respective proportions of registration fees for all State/Territory Associations for three years to enable the them to increase their membership without incurring any additional costs, and to enable them to raise more revenue for themselves. Table Tennis SA should take full advantage of this situation.

Table Tennis SA's fee structure has remained virtually unchanged over the last few years and this has placed our State in a marking time mode. Like any progressive sport, we must raise our revenue base to enable us to look into the future with an aim to raise the profile of table tennis, and to plan for our sport to take its rightful place in the sporting world.

While we treat table tennis as a second sport then we will be viewed, by all people outside of our sport, in the same light. The only people who can change this concept are the table tennis players who believe in our sport. The way in which this can be turned around is for members being more willing to accept a higher fee structure and to take their place on Club and Association Committees. Table Tennis SA committee members have been extremely overworked due to the lack of numbers.

Table Tennis SA needs more financial backing from the members to enable them to fulfil programs that they and the affiliates would like to see implemented for the future development of the sport.

We now have a Presidents and Secretaries Meeting held regularly as was requested by the affiliates and I believe these meetings have been fruitful in conveying the wishes of the affiliates to the Board.

Over the last few years I have been all over the state coaching in schools and associations and have been quite enthused by the reception and friendship afforded to me by those I have visited.

Like all previous Presidents, I would like to feel that I have made an impact on table tennis during my term in office but we nearly all leave feeling we have never done quite enough.

When I became President, I stated that we needed to put more work into player participation on the table and previously too much emphasis had been placed on administration. I believe the time has come for administration to take a more active role owing to the nature of the Office of Sport and Recreation funding and a variety of other Government policies which is becoming more and more demanding of all sporting organisations. My work load has been quite heavy in many other areas of table tennis and my family commitments are becoming more demanding, therefore I will not be standing for the position of President this year.

I would like to wish the new President and Board Members all the best for the future.



#### TASMANIA CHAIRMAN'S REPORT

In 2002 our player numbers remained relatively static. We continue to struggle to maintain entry levels in the open tournaments despite the continued endeavours of the branch tournament committees to present quality events. I believe that the time has come for the TTTA Council to look at all aspects of the open tournaments which are conducted to see what all stakeholders want.

Devonport, Eastside and STTTA all conducted junior coaching events this year utilising grant funds from the Office of Sport & Recreation. These were all very successful undertakings and these branches are to be congratulated for their initiative. We have some funds left over which will be utilized in 2003.

I resigned as Finance Director of Table Tennis Australia in December 2001. This position is still vacant on the TTA Board as is at least one other directorship. I believe that the TTA Board is heading in the right direction and that the CEO, Matty Padley, is doing an excellent job with limited resources available to her. However, in my opinion there is still room for further improvement in the TTA Board's processes. Bill Atkinson's report provides additional information on the situation at TTA.

Maureen Sherman is too modest to include in her Technical Director's Report the fact that in 2002 she received her accreditation as in ITTF International Umpire. Congratulations Maureen!

I once again wish to thank all the TTTA Board members for their contributions during 2002. My job as Chairman is made easier by the confidence I have that all the Directors are capable in carrying out the duties under their portfolios and always do so to the best of their abilities. Thank you to Bill Atkinson for his attention to National Affairs, Maureen Sherman for continuing to keep us all up to scratch on technical matters, Doug McLean for his excellent work in keeping our website up to date and getting us media coverage wherever possible, Elaine Wright for attending to the administration portfolio, and finally, Margaret Turner for succeeding in keeping us on the straight and narrow financially.

I thank the Branches and the Branch Delegates for their attention to matters raised during 2002.

It is with sadness that I record the death in December 2002 of Ralph Wilcox a Life Member of the TITA.

I would like to thank the TTQ Board for giving me the opportunity to join the Board as President after the resignation of Tracy Smith in June, and thank Tracy for his contribution to TTQ and wish him every success in the future.

The Board has been instrumental in conjunction with Linda Lyell at formulating and enforcing selection and complaint policies in 2002. While still requiring some fine-tuning, these documents will help simplify the administration of our sport and produce more consistent results for our members.

This year saw the trial of the Grand Prix in open events at regional tournaments. Some teething problems occurred and the outcome was not achieved as expected, however the development forum held in November felt it was appropriate to continue the concept and apply it to reserve grade in 2002 to target increased participation in that group.

Linda has done a great job in securing the help of volunteers to increase the office output while keeping costs to a minimum. In 2002, one of the most noticeable outcomes of this volunteer assistance was the upgrade of the Table Tennis Queensland website performed by office volunteer Kristen Collier, under the direction of Linda. It is great to see many of our clubs now have websites. They are an effective tool in promotion and communication with the broader community. I encourage all clubs to explore this avenue of communication.

The development forum held in November was well attended, and not only acted as a forum to discuss the future direction of table tennis in Queensland, but also served as a vehicle to bring club representatives closer together. Because of the vastness of our state there is a need to bring the clubs together as much as possible so as to encourage closer cooperation between us for the growth of the sport in Queensland.

One important item to come from the development forum was the need to develop a statewide coaching strategy. Linda has applied for and received funding for a part time Coach Development Officer whose role will be to increase the number and standard of accredited coaches in Queensland and assist all clubs to implement a standardised coaching strategy. Applications have been called for and the successful applicant will be appointed by February. We expect the successful applicant to be on the job soon after.

Once again our elite players have represented Table Tennis Queensland admirably with Peri Campbell-Innes and Brett Clarke winning silver medals at the recent Commonwealth Games in Manchester. This year the national senior titles are to be held at Wynnum. This will be an excellent opportunity for players and officials to experience the best of Australia play in Queensland.

Our membership base is heavily weighted towards veterans. The passing on of Harry Akker was a blow to many in Southeast Queensland. He played in at least four clubs every week and his contribution to Table Tennis will be missed. His passing brings realisation that our playing base being aged, and needs an influx of youth in the near future.

The inability of some clubs to insure themselves for Public Liability has helped Table Tennis Queensland gain new members. Clubs joining Table Tennis Queensland are covered for Public Liability in their affiliation fees. Growth in membership is expected in the coming year with several existing clubs, now interested in affiliating and registering a great deal more members with TTQ.

Linda Lyell has been on a State-wide tour this year and has gained a closer working relationship with clubs. Her feedback to the board has been invaluable in helping the board make sound decisions for the advancement of our sport.

The introduction of the shortened game to 11 this year has brought conflicting views from players. Most have accepted the change and there is no choice in competition but to follow the new rule. Clubs with social players are able to be flexible on rules played within their club. Retaining the 21 game may be considered by social clubs to help retain players preferring to play as they have in the past.

To all the Referees, Umpires, Committee members and other volunteers who give unselfishly of their time to our sport, I thank you on behalf of the TTQ Board. I encourage all members to participate in the administration or officiating of Table Tennis in Queensland.

In 2003 the Board has many hurdles to overcome including the improvement of the quality and equity of service to members. Some clubs have become used to the handout mentality. This is a whole of Queensland issue and the solution will require whole of Queensland involvement.

In conclusion it is my opinion the future of table tennis in Queensland is very positive. I thank Linda Lyell, the Board and all who have contributed to the advancement of Table Tennis in Queensland and encourage further participation from all quarters in 2003. The success of our sport begins at the grassroots of each club, and will require the collective efforts of all members state-wide. I look forward to working together towards our common goals.

#### BUSINESS

TTV had a successful 2002, recording a small profit, which was a significant improvement from our large loss in 2001.

#### **OPERATIONS**

TTV successfully hosted the Australian Youth, Junior, and Veterans championships and the World Masters Championships in 2002, in addition to its large existing tournament schedule and day to day operations. Congratulations must go to the TTV staff and our incredible volunteers for their enormous efforts to support these major events.

#### PHILOSOPHY

Competitive table tennis participation can be characterised as an equilateral triangle. If we broaden the base then the peak will rise. Equally, if we push the peak up then the base will broaden. Unfortunately our table tennis pyramid in Victoria has been shrinking. New initiatives have recently been approved to build both the base and the peak. In January a recruitment drive pilot was successfully run which showed enormous promise for future years and has also introduced a new sponsor to table tennis. An expanded schools competition also shows the promise of introducing thousands of new juniors to our ranks. At the peak level we are reintroducing the Victorian Senior Squad Training Program and have just negotiated a small program for selected players with the Victorian Institute of Sport. We plan to expand that program next year, 'piggy-backing' the Commonwealth Games preparatory funding. A keystone of the new philosophy for elite players will be the professionalism of our athletes and accordingly we have attracted a significant new uniform sponsorship to help our athletes look the part as they proudly represent Victoria.



#### WESTERN AUSTRALIA REPORT ON ACTIVITIES

Irwin Parker

Again the Association had quite a successful year despite a number of voluntary positions not being filled. Overall membership grew by some 8% in 2002 and a lot more people have volunteered for positions in 2003 including that of newsletter (renamed to "11UP") editor. Although the Association has successfully conducted a number of Annual Dinners, including one in 2002, the appointment, after a number of year's absence, of a Social and Fund Raising Director should ensure an increase in activity in 2003.

The year's activities commenced with the aftermath of the National Veterans Championship and the planning for the National Senior Championships. The Senior Championship was run successfully, which would not have been possible without the dedication shown by the organising committee (John Flynn, Dave Cooper, Phil Evans, Ron Gallagher, Lyn Smallacombe and myself) and the assistance of numerous volunteers. The organising committee was stretched to the limit, bearing in mind that most were also on the organising committee for last years National Veterans Championship.

Dave Cooper took on responsibilities for both tournaments and pennants, handling both positions well, with the able assistance of his sub-committee members. The overall increase in the number of pennant teams was quite pleasing. Long serving scorer, Chris Marsh, continued to do a most efficient job and further improved the Association Web site which provides up to date information on pennants plus a multitude of additional information.

The Association Junior Development program, sponsored by Healthway with assistance from the Department of Sport & Recreation, continued on from previous years. This was in part due to the assistance received from a number of parents including Penelope Whitby and Nikki Bolt. In addition to the junior coaching stalwarts Phil Ranger, David Brown and Peter Mascall, it was pleasing to see some of the new coaches becoming involved including coaching director Charles Crock. Five of those who attended the Level 1 Coaching Accreditation Course conducted by Glen Tepper in January 2001 have now achieved Level 1 status. Also all 10 probationary State Umpires received their badges plus another 14 achieved Association Umpire (level 1) status.

As usual, the highlight of the local calendar was the State Championship, which received an excellent entry, and featured former international player Vladimir Janci. Vladimir, an accredited coach, has also been involved in junior coaching and undertook some private coaching for clubs and for individuals. Courtesy of the work of Cedric Wilson the Association was able to continue to upgrade the Centre parking area. Garden beds have been established and planted, because of generous donations of time and plants by members, and also drainage has been improved. The installation of underground power and the new housing currently being built on the adjacent block should further enhance the outside appearance of the centre.

Overall the Association's financial situation is healthy being mainly due to the \$8825 profit made on conducting the National Veterans Championship in October 2001. Basically there was an all-square result from other activities, which as usual were to a large degree financed from the Centre profit. Also the Association was able to absorb the loss made on conducting the National Senior Championship, and meet the cost of installation of underground power.
